- A separate semen package will be sold in the USA and Canada.
- No semen has been sold or transferred or will be sold and transferred in advance of the date of this sale.
- The semen package for each country will consist of 300 units of semen. The semen will be provided in 2007 with at least 100 units of semen to be provided on or before April 1, 2007.
- The purchaser of the semen package in each country will consist of not more than 3 individual ranches or farms. No partnerships or other interests will be permitted at any time. The participants in the semen package for each country will be announced at the conclusion of the bidding from the auction block. No participant in the purchase of a semen package may transfer all or any part of his interest in the semen package at any time or for any reason.
- No semen will be sold, transferred or used by anyone other than the participants in the purchase of each semen package in Canada, the USA, and YCR before January 1, 2010. It is the intention of YCR and the purchasers of the semen packages that the use of the semen will be exclusive to each for the breeding of females owned 100% by each until January 1, 2010.
- After January 1, 2010, each participant of the purchase of the semen packages may sell any remaining semen in the country of his purchase for his or her own account. YCR may also sell semen in Canada or the USA after that date with the allocation of the net income herein provided for.
- Each semen package purchased in the USA and Canada will have an entitlement to share in the net income produced by semen sales in other countries following the auction or in the USA and Canada after January 1, 2010. Each "country" will receive will receive 25% of the net income realized from semen sales for a total of 50% for both countries and YCR will have a 50% interest in the net income from semen sales. The participants in the purchase of each semen package will distribute the 25% among themselves as they might agree.
- Should the bull not produce semen that will freeze, then the purchase price paid by purchasers will be refunded as full payment of and satisfaction of any and all damages. Possession and control of all decisions concerning the bull will remain with YCR. Purchasers are not buying any interest in the bull. Total ownership of the bull will remain with YCR.

Celtic Fleckvieh is part of a family-run cattle and mixed grain farm. Simmental/Fleckvieh have been utilized on our farm since 1971. We have 300+ breeding females, with the majority being 100% Full Fleckvieh Fullbloods, along with Polled Fullbloods and Polled Purebreds from Fleckvieh lines.

Our polled genetics are based on foundation Fleckvieh lines and the use of several outcross sires and dams. Moderate frame, feet, legs and very good maternal qualities (calving ease, udder, etc) are important to us.

Performance is based on a high forage diet. We are able to graze for 8-9 months using stockpiled native range, winter grazing of corn and field crop stubble supplemented with alfalfa hay. With this management practice we are able to select animals that are excelling in a more natural environment, the performance is in the genes not the feed.

Our calving season is in the late spring on grass. The Celtic Fleckvieh herd maternal qualities shine in this environment. The mothering abilities color (pigmentation on the underline and eyes) combined with the polled factor help to reduce our labor and intervention on the cow and newborn calf.

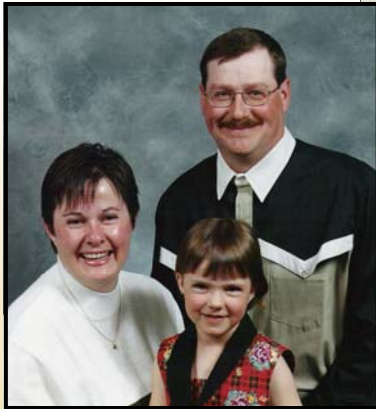

Spruceburn Simmentals began in 1974 with the birth of half Fleckvieh calves from Hereford cows. Thereafter, popular AI bulls were used. In 1982, the decision was made to stock to Fleckvieh bloodlines and we purchased six year old SAF 73H, a Solway Adonis son. He was an outstanding female producer. Our next bull, BEL C&B Western 4th, crossed very well with 73H daughters. Presently 75% of the cows are AI'd and cleaned up by a 73H son and a Moses son. Our herd consists of 40 Full Fleckvieh cows.

We have been selecting for moderate, easy fleshing cattle that grow fast and hang up top quality tender carcasses at 13-14 months. Docility and structural correctness have been at the top of our selection criteria. Recently we have been adding some polled bloodlines, due to customer demand, and also due to the realization that animal rightists are gaining huge power and will force this change in the future. As well, the full Fleck polled bulls being bred now are a huge improvement on the early polled fullbloods.

Yankee Creek Ranch has been breeding polled cattle of the Fleckvieh Breed longer than anyone else in North America. We started in 1983 with our historical acquisition of Miss Tino Unipolled. This is an exclusive YCR polled bloodline. We diversified and increased the progeny from this foundation cow by breeding the polled female offspring to the best horned Fleckvieh bulls and breeding the best horned females to our polled Fleckvieh bulls. In order to further diversify our genetic base, we recently used semen imported to North America by Bavarian Fleckvieh Genetics from the Eisenherz and Emperor lines. We also acquired some genetics from the Grinde herd. Our polled genetics are pure. They can be traced back to polled mutations from horned Fleckvieh cattle. They do not have any influence from any other breed or grade animal.

The polled feature is demanded by the purebred and commercial sector because of the elimination of the expense and time consuming dehorning process. Animal rights advocates are applying ever increasing pressure to eliminate mechanical dehorning. In some locations in the EU, dehorning can only be done by a licensed veterinarian. Polled Fleckvieh cattle are the breed of the future.
